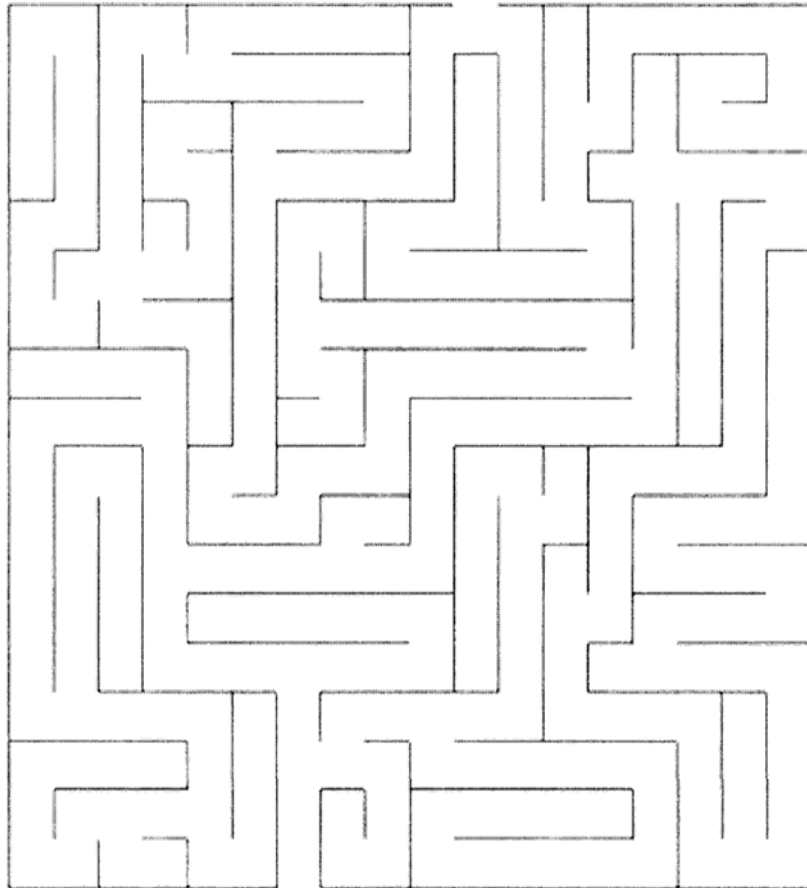

Now Thomas (called Didymus), one of the twelve, was not with the disciples when Jesus came. So the other disciples told him, "We have seen the Lord!"

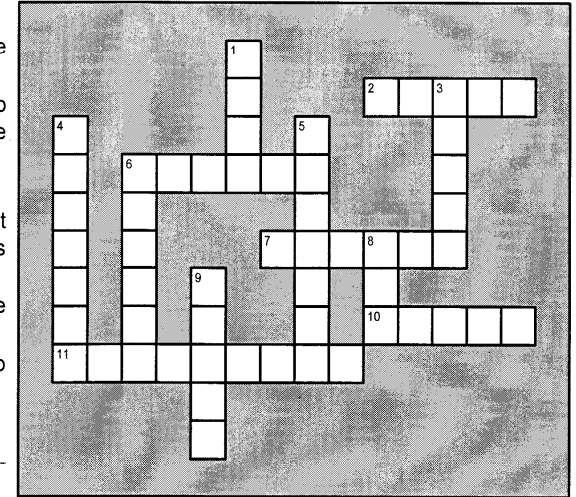
Dear Jesus, we have come into this house and gathered in your name today because we want to be with you. We have come to worship and praise your name. **Amen.**
